


1050 X 31 X 1MM BUDGET HEX NET



Description

1050 x 31 x 1mm Budget Hex Net is our most popular rabbit netting, offering a cost effective solution to rabbit control. Integrated salvage wires provide additional strength, and the net can be turned out if required to prevent burrowing underneath. We would always recommend using Tornado Premium rabbit netting; however, we understand that sometimes a fence is only required for a short period of time. Although still heavily galvanised, this netting is not recommended for grant work.

Installation Guidelines

Rabbit netting should be supported by three line wires positioned at the top, middle and bottom of the net. The wires should be either 2.5mm or 3.15mm High Tensile. They should be tied off and joined using suitable joiners before being tensioned between the straining posts. A straining post is required at every major change in direction or any termination and should be supported by a strut or box assembly. The bottom 150mm of the netting can be turned out to help prevent the rabbit burrowing under the fence. Zinc and zinc aluminium coated agricultural fence service life can be affected significantly when exposed to extremely acidic / alkaline or saline environments and this factor should be considered when designing your fence installation. For typical service life to be achieved it is recommended that the product must be installed in an atmosphere with corrosion class C1, C2 or C3 (very low/low/ medium) in accordance with ISO 9223 and

must not come into contact with substances that will accelerate corrosion, including but not limited to fertilisers, pesticides, herbicides, salt water and soils of pH lower than 5.5. Particularly at sites with peaty and wet ground conditions it is recommended that you have the soil pH tested prior to designing your installation. When all three strands of wire have been installed the rabbit netting can be rolled out, stretched slightly by hand and clipped to the line wires approximately every metre using suitable clips. For more information on installation please refer to BS1722 part 2.
